

Dear Students,

I am writing early in the academic year to remind you of WVU Tech's long-standing on-campus housing requirement so you that you will have plenty of time to arrange to meet this requirement for the upcoming 2020-21 academic year. The requirement states:

All full-time students with fewer than 59 earned credit hours (including transfer credits) are required to live in University housing unless one of the following exceptions applies:

- *Student will be residing with a custodial parent(s)/guardian(s) within a commuting distance of 50 miles of campus*
- *Student is married*
- *Student has a child(ren)*
- *Student will be 21 years of age by the first day of classes*

Students to whom the housing requirement applies are expected to reside in university housing for the 2020-21 academic year, regardless of whether a housing exemption has been granted in the past. [Housing applications for the 2020-21 academic year](#) will be accepted online beginning October 10, 2019.
